



The Meaning of Peace

Peace is not merely the absence of war, conflict, or violence. It is an attitude, a way of life where human beings are in total harmony with nature, God, self, and others.

Steps to Peace

We must change behaviors such as putting down others, bullying others, hurting others, being prejudiced against others, and ignoring others' needs. These changes in attitude and behavior are small steps to peace and will lead to ever-widening circles of peace breaking out in the world.

We Listen

The story of Doubting Thomas teaches us a great deal about peace, faith, doubt, and mercy. That is a lot to pack into one story! The Gospel starts with a greeting of peace and then we see Thomas doubt. His unbelief leads him to belief once he sees the Risen Lord. And then, even though Thomas showed an initial lack of faith, Jesus shows mercy to Thomas.
